




The Public Design Commission (POC) is New York City's design review agency. Established as the Municipal Art Commission in 1998, the agency was renamed the Public Design Commission in 2008 to better reflect its mission and purview. As an advocate for excellence and innovation in the public realm. In the PDC works to ensure the quality and viability of public projects, programs, and services for New Yorkers in all five boroughs for years to come.

The PDC reviews permanent works of architecture, landscape architecture, and art proposed on or over City-owned property. Projects vary in size and scope, and include but are not limited to the construction, renovation, or restoration of buildings, the creation or relabilitation of parks, playgrounds, and plazes, installation of lighting and other streatscape elements; signagi; and the installation and conservation of artworks and memorials

The PDC acts as caretaker and curator of the City's public art collection, which is located throughout public buildings and open spaces in New York City. The PDC also maintains an extensive archive of projects reviewed by the Commission since 1902, documenting more than 7000 sites throughout New York City and providing a unique view into the history of the City's public works.






Sustainably manage and protect marine and coastal ecosystems to avoid significant adverse impacts, including by strengthening their resilience and taking action for their restoration.


